CISA International 420 Charter Program

CISA has a new fleet of 9 I-420's, which will be used for the first time at the 2009 Thanksgiving I-420 Clinic. CISA plans to make the boats available for charter to qualified California teams for the ISAF Youth World Qualifier, US Youth Championships and other I-420 regattas.

Boats will be available without sails for \$150/day. Interested sailors should submit a charter request including training and regatta plan, sailing resume, proof of insurance (driver & tow vehicle) to Danielle Richards danielle@odmsail.com 30 days prior to the requested charter start date. Transportation and insurance coverage is the responsibility of the charterer.

Once approved a charter agreement will be sent to the team and must be returned with all insurance documents before the boats may leave CISA property.

Transportation/Insurance Plan:

Before the boat(s) may leave CISA property an approved travel plan and copies of driver, vehicle and borrowed boat insurance must be on file with the CISA Office in addition to a copy of the towers driving record.

The Charterer shall obtain and maintain in force an all risk policy of hull insurance in the minimum amount of the full replacement value of the Yacht to protect them against "all risks." The hull portion of this insurance shall include a 438BFU endorsement in favor of the Owner. The insurance shall be provided by an insurance carrier that is rated A in Best's Key Guide to insurance and liability protection and indemnity coverage shall be carried in an amount of not less than \$500,000. The policy shall contain defined geographical navigational limits in which the Yacht will be navigated. If the Yacht is to be used by the Charterer outside of the defined limits of navigation, written notification shall be provided by the Charterer to Clark Garvey Insurance, 245 Fischer Avenue, Costa Mesa, California 92626. The insurance shall carry a thirty (30) day notice of cancellation, with written notice to be directed by the Charterer to Clark Garvey Insurance. The Charterer shall be named as the primary insured and the Owner shall be named as an additional insured or as a loss payee. Any damage to the Yacht or any personal injury not covered by, or in excess of insurance, shall be paid by the Charterer.
